I am requesting funding for the Perinton Community Center & Playground Access Improvement Initiative in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Town of Perinton, located at 1350 Turk Hill Road, Fairport, NY 14450.

The funding would be used for the demolition of deteriorating and inadequate park playground equipment, and reconstruction of more inclusive amenities in a more accessible location on the same property site. ADA compliant amenities include connecting sidewalks, entry areas and greater access to the information desk, enhancing the overall mobility throughout the facility. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it removes architectural barriers at the multipurpose community center site, minimizing current mobility and accessibility restrictions particularly for elderly and handicapped persons, growing the number of populations able to directly engage and interact in the Town's numerous community-driven, as well as publicly available program offerings.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
