I am requesting funding for the Rochester Genesee Regional Transportation Authority Hydrogen Fueler Boil Off Capture System in fiscal year 2026.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Rochester Genesee Regional Transportation Authority, located at 1372 East Main Street, Rochester, NY 14609.

The funding would be used for a boil-off capture system that would collect, compress, and store the evaporated hydrogen gas so it can be reused to fuel the buses. This system not only prevents waste and reduces environmental impact but also offers fuel savings and provides a valuable backup fueling option if the main liquid fueler is offline for maintenance.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
