4 This Act may be cited as the "Pell Grant Flexibility5 Act".

1 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT OF 2 1965. 3 Section 401(b)(2) of the Higher Education Act of 4 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(2)) is amended— 5 (1) by striking "In any case" and inserting the 6 following: 7 "(A) REDUCTION.—Except as provided in 8 subparagraph (B), in any case"; and 9 (2) by adding at the end the following: 10 "(B) STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES.— 11 "(i) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a 12 student with a disability (as defined in sec-13 tion 3 of the Americans with Disabilities 14 Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12102)) for whom 15 a reduced course load has been determined 16 appropriate by the institution of higher education, the student's enrollment in the 17 18 reduced course load or 5 credits (or the 19 equivalent), whichever is greater, shall be 20 deemed to be enrollment on a full-time 21 basis for purposes of calculating the 22 amount of the Federal Pell Grant to which 23 the student is entitled. 24 "(ii) LIMITED APPLICATION.—A de-
