## RESOLUTION

- Expressing support for the designation of March 3, 2025, as "National Triple-Negative Breast Cancer Day".
- Whereas triple-negative breast cancer was recognized as a distinct type of cancer in 2006;
- Whereas triple-negative breast cancer disproportionately affects young women, Black and Hispanic women, and those with BRCA gene mutations;
- Whereas triple-negative breast cancers are estrogen receptornegative, progesterone receptor-negative, and HER2-negative, making them distinct from other breast cancers;
- Whereas 10 to 15 percent of all breast cancer diagnoses are designated as triple-negative;
- Whereas triple-negative breast cancer can be more aggressive and more likely to spread and recur;

- Whereas triple-negative breast cancer accounts for around 25 percent of all deaths from breast cancer in the United States; and
- Whereas March 3, 2025, would be an appropriate date to designate as "National Triple-Negative Breast Cancer Day": Now, therefore, be it
